The Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar Association, by its Executive Director, Deborah O'Regan, in accordance with Rule 4, Section 4, of the Alaska Bar Rules, certifies to this Court the following results of the February 2003 Alaska Bar Examination and respectfully petitions the Court to grant the admission of those applicants qualified for admission:

1. The Alaska Bar Association conducted a bar examination on February 25, 26 and 27, 2003 in which a total of 53 applicants were examined.

2. The examination was comprised of the following: the first day of the examination consisted of three "long" essay questions given in the morning and two MPT questions given in the afternoon; the MBE, a multiple-choice examination, was

given on the second day of the examination; six "short" essay questions were given on the third morning of the exam.

3. The Alaska Committee of Law Examiners certified its written report of the February 2003 Alaska Bar Examination to the Board of Governors on May 1, 2003. The Committee followed Rule 4, Section 3, of the Alaska Bar Rules. The components of the exam were weighted as follows: Essay portion, 50%; MBE, 50%; with the essay portion sub-weighted as follows: the three long essays, 30%; the six short essays, 45%; the two MPT questions, 25%. A combined score of 140 or above was the passing score on the examination. Twenty-seven (27) applicants were certified by the Committee as having received a score of 140 or above. Twenty-six (26) applicants were certified as having received scores below 140.

4. On May 5, 2003, the Board of Governors, based upon the recommendations of the Executive Director, and such other matters as it considered pertinent, determined that the following twenty-seven (27) applicants, receiving scores of 140 or above and eligible in all other respects, were qualified for admission to the practice of law in Alaska:

The Board of Governors, based upon the Committee's report of examination, the recommendations of the Executive Director, and such other matters as it considered pertinent, determined that twenty-six (26) applicants had received scores below 140 and had failed to demonstrate their qualifications for admission to the practice of law in Alaska.

WHEREFORE, the Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar Association recommends, upon the filing of proof of compliance with the provisions of Rule 5 of the Alaska Bar Rules, that the twenty-seven (27) applicants listed in paragraph four (4)


above be admitted to the practice of law in Alaska and
