To all who shall see these Presents, Greeting:

Know Ye: That reposing special trust and confidence in the Wisdom, Affluence, and Learning of James H. Singleton, Jr., of Alaska, I have nominated, and, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, do appoint him United States District Judge for the District of Alaska and do authorize and empower him to execute and fulfil the duties of that Office, according to the Constitution and Laws of the said United States, and to Hold the said Office, with all the powers, privileges and emoluments to the same of right appertaining, unto Him, the said James H. Singleton, Jr., during his good behavior.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made patent and the seal of the Department of Justice to be hereunto affixed.

Given at the City of Washington this fourteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ninety, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred and fourteenth.
